

Earnings Impress Despite Operating Inefficiency

Riding on Support From its Life Business

In its recently released Q1:2020 financial scorecard, AIICO Insurance Plc (AIICO) sustained the healthy top-line performance that has characterized the preceding four quarters. During the Q1:2020 period, GPI expanded by +22.61% YoY to NGN15.19bn (vs. NGN12.39bn in Q1:2019). This performance was however weaker than the 34.99% YoY growth recorded in 2019FY as the growth across its life and non-life business segments moderated to +29.10% and +3.77% respectively (as against the 2019FY performance of +40.74% and +21.59%). The health maintenance business bucked the trend as it outperformed Q1:2019 levels, growing by 9.66% to NGN0.15bn (vs. NGN0.13bn in the corresponding period of 2019) albeit it accounts for just 0.96% of overall topline. The Life business which typically contributes c. 66.80% to topline maintained is leadership position, accounting for 78.07% of topline performance in Q1:2020. Despite the Q1:2020 performance, we expect the impact of COVID-19 to be felt in general disposable income. Hence, we project a deceleration in growth by 10.00% to slow GPI to NGN55.01bn in FY2020.

Underwriting Inefficiency Pressures Performance

During the period, loss ratio deteriorated to 58.00% (vs. 57.82% in Q1:2019) due to higher claims payment - which inched up by 20.14% to NGN7.72bn in Q1:2020. Benefits paid on life business constituted 90.00% (vs. 86.11% in Q1:2019) of the total settlements, dipping underwriting performance by NGN1.08bn in the period. Underwriting expenses however declined by 25.49% YoY to NGN6.45bn, improving combined ratio to 100.44% (vs. 127.66% in Q1:2019) in the process. Despite this improvement, the firm's position still lags the industry average of c. 93.05%. Noteworthy also, is that combined ratio has trended above 100.00% (Usually triggered by the firms provision for life and annuity fund) for the past three (2017-2019) years. Similarly, in Q1:2020, the firm recorded a loss of NGN0.32bn on its insurance business (Solely influenced by the loss incurred on life business).

Investment Income Supports Profit After Tax

Investment income grew by 48.38% YoY to NGN3.79bn (vs. NGN2.56bn in Q1:2019) following an improved performance on interest-income which grew by 47.89% in Q1:2020. Thus, investment yield improved to 2.44% (vs. 1.87% in the corresponding period of 2019). Management and other operating expenses also rose by 33.35% YoY to NGN3.69bn, hinged on expansion in employee benefit expenses (+38.10% YoY), other operating expenses (+39.83% YoY), and finance costs (+38.87% YoY) respectively. As a consequence, overhead ratio climbed to 24.29%, from 22.33% in Q1:2019. Nonetheless, profit after tax rose by 82.81% to NGN1.88bn in the period, pegging net margin at 12.35%, a marked improvement from the 8.29% recorded as at Q1:2019.

Balance Sheet Strength Allays Recapitalization Fears

AIICO's current capital position of NGN19.24bn as at Q1:2020 places the insurer comfortably above the regulator's NGN18.00bn recapitalization threshold required of composite businesses. The company's financial assets also expanded by 13.36% to NGN155.20bn during the period. This rise hinged on the 74.31% improvement in float reported in the period. Thus, providing an avenue for the business to ramp more interest income in the latter part of FY2020.

Outlook and Recommendation

For 2020FY, we have modelled our expectation of an improvement in EPS to NGN0.54. This combined with our target PE of 3.60x yields a target price of NGN1.94, which when compared to the current price of NGN1.06 implies an upside potential of 83.40%. Hence, we rate the ticker as a **BUY**.

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Target Price Estimate

While we believe that the fair value is underpinned by the future benefits stream and growth outlooks, which are primary drivers of value, the market might not align to the fair value estimate within the estimated investment horizon. Thus, we do not derive our target price from the fair value but from a trading perspective using the year projected earnings or book value and the respective target multiples. Notwithstanding, we are of the opinion that the variance between the two should not be too significant.
