

### What Moved the Markets this Week?

### Nigeria | November 20, 2020


Profit-taking activities, which came as a sequel to the momentous leap in the previous week, clipped the NSEAS In the just concluded trading week, as it dropped 2.57% to dose at 34,136.82pts. Under our coverage (Except the insurance sector), every industry dosed in the negative, with the banking sector shedding the most at 5.98% WID. The market activities also showed BOCGAS as the top gainer for the week, as its share price rose by 39.88%, while WAPIC, shedding 21.15%, ended the week as the biggest laggard.


The National Bureau of Statistics released the inflation report for October 2020, with headline inflation rising by 14.25% Yo Y (xs. 14.09%YOY as of September). The food index rose the most, surging by 17.38 TOY and recording a 72bps rise over the September figure. There were earnings rele ases in the week, as GUARANTY, 2ENTH, ACCESA, and STERLING bank reported their of 3.2020 performance with modest outcomes across the board.

There was a bond auction in the week, Investors oversubscribed the offer as evinced by respective bid -to-cover of 2.20x and 2.43x on the offered tenors. In the secondary market, yields continued to plummet in both the T-bills and Bonds space, as average yields declined by 23bps and 11bps to end the week at 0.09% and 3.91%, respectively.


