## What Moved the Markets this Week?

Bearish sentiments dominated the Nigerian bourse this week as the market closed negative on three of the five trading days of the week. Thus, the All share index shed 0.57%WoW to settle at 39,261.01pts, dragging Year-to-date losses further to -2.51%. Across sectors, only the NGXINS (+0.79%WoW) gained while the NGXBNK (-0.58%WoW), NGXCNSMRGDS (-1.34%WoW), NGXOILGAS (-2.96%WoW), and NGXINDSTR (-0.89%WoW) closed in the red. TRANSCOHOT appreciated by 10.00%WoW to emerge as the week's top gainer while OANDO (-15.21%WoW) was the top loser for the week. TRANSCORP and ZENITHBANK were the most traded stocks during the week by volume and value, respectively.

On the corporate scene, ACCESSBANK released its H1:2021 audited financial results, reporting a 13.58%YOY and 42.44%YOY increase in Gross earnings and profit after tax, respectively. The bank also declared an interim dividend of NGN0.30k per share.


In the secondary market for fixed income instruments, the sentiments was mixed as average bond yields declined to 10.49% (vs 10.67% at the end of the previous week) while average T-bills yield increased slightly to 4.73% (vs 4.71% at the end of the previous week).


